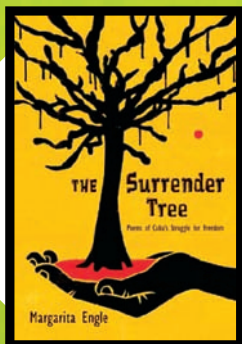
October 3, 2009 • 2:00 pm
